ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING - THURSDAY 8th OCTOBER 2009

MINUTES

Meeting commenced at 8.50pm with Mr Dec Forde in the chair.

Teams represented: New White Bull A, New White Bull B, Royal Oak, Waggon & Horses, Greasley Miners Welfare, Foresters, Seven Stars.

- 1) Apologies received from representatives of The Steampacket and Poet & Castle
- 2) There were no matters arising from the minutes of the previous AGM
- 3) The Treasurer presented a comprehensive set of accounts which were accepted unanimously (Prop. Dan Troke, Sec. Tom Hickingbottom).

As usual there was nothing to report from the secretary.

4. Mr Dec Forde was re-elected chairman on the understanding there would be a vice chairman to limit the powers of the chairman's position. (Prop. Angie Dickinson, Sec. John Carrington). Greg Nicholas was elected to the new post of Vice Chairman (Prop. Kevan Reeves, Sec. Tom Hickingbottom). Kevan Reeves was elected Secretary (Prop. Sue Brady, Sec. Mike Key). Angie Dickinson was re-elected Treasurer (Prop. Dave, Sec. Kevan Reeves) and Anthony Williams was re-elected Fixtures Secretary (Prop. Tom Hickingbottom, Sec. Dan Troke).
5. Following discussion of the treasurer's report, a vote was proposed to lower the team subscription to £50 for the 2009/2010 season. (Prop. Sue Brady, Sec. Leslie Carrington). This was carried unanimously.
6. The floor was given to Andy Walters to discuss the events surrounding the end of the 2008/2009 season. Following these events a review of the rules and regulations subsequently took place (See section 9) and the chairman gave an apology for the way things were handled. It was agreed that this was an end to the matter and that with the now 5 person committee, such events should not be allowed to happen again.
7. It was felt that there would be 9 teams again this season with the resignation of the Royal Oak and the welcome return of a second team at the Foresters. Following much discussion Greg Nicholas proposed that the final round of matches be changed from buzzer to "Ping-Pong" format (Sec. Paul Barton). This was carried by majority vote.
8. The presentation evening and Singles Competition will take place on October 29th at the New White Bull.
9. As there were no matters arising from the review of the rules & regulations, the chairman thanked Angie Dickinson for her work and reminded all that these were the rules by which the league is bound.
10. The only AOB item raised was the Chairman's remuneration. The chairman declared that he was happy to maintain the status quo
